

Rights Of Victims in Public Transport Accidents



Who is Entitled to Compensation?

- Injured Passengers (occupants) of the vehicle
- Respective Family Members in the event of death (including persons living in a civil partnership)



What are the Main Rights of Victims and their Families?

Right to medical assistance.

What are the Main Rights of Victims and their Families?

Compensation for Non-property Damage:



SUFFERING AND EMOTIONAL IMPACT



(AESTHETIC DAMAGE AND 'BIOLOGICAL DAMAGE')



THE DAMAGE MAY AFFECT PHYSICAL OR PSYCHOLOGICAL FUNCTIONAL CAPACITIES AND LOSS OF QUALITY OF LIFE





What are the Three Steps that the Victim should Take:


- 1. Seek specialised support (medical and legal)
- Participate in compulsory motor vehicle liability insurance and other complementary or subsidiary insurance
- 3. Collect and store evidence
- 4. If there is no agreement:

TAKE THE MATTER TO COURT



How Long does the Victim have to Take Action?

Report the incident to the insurance company: as soon as possible.

Limitation period for legal action:



RULE: 3 YEARS (FROM THE DATE OF THE INCIDENT)



EXCEPTION: 5 YEARS
(IF THE HARMFUL EVENT CONSTITUTES A CRIME)





What is the Jurisdiction and Competent Court in the Event of a Dispute?

General Rule:

District Court of the Place of the Accident - Portugal, District of Lisbon


I Exception:

Place of Residence

In addition to collective civil liability insurance, there may be other types of insurance that complement the coverage:




PERSONAL OR TOURIST ACCIDENTS



ACCIDENTS AT WORK



TRAVEL INSURANCE OR CREDIT CARD



INDIVIDUAL LIFE INSURANCE

IMPORTANT: SOME COMPENSATION MAY BE CUMULATIVE (E.G. PASSENGER INSURANCE + TRAVEL INSURANCE). OTHERS: CANNOT BE COMBINED (E.G. WORK ACCIDENT + MOTOR VEHICLE CIVIL LIABILITY FOR THE SAME DAMAGE).
